City Council Meeting

Wednesday, March 11th 2026

The City of Bromley met in a regular session on Wednesday March 11th 2026 at 6:00 PM, with a pledge to the flag and Mayor Mike Denham presiding.

Mike Kendall made a motion to allow Councilman Andrew Clift to take minutes, seconded by Dave Radford.

Roll Call – Mike Kendall, Dave Radford, Kely Dudley and Andrew Clift all present. Councilman Tim Wartman was absent.

Call to Order – Staff Present: Solicitor Matt Woods, Police Chief Cody Stanley, Fire Chief Mike Steward, Public Works Jack Dudley. City Clerk Brittany Hinzman was absent.

Approval of minutes— Kelly Dudley motioned, Mike Kendall seconded, all voting in favor.

Citizens Report— No Citizens had comments.

PDS— Motion made to approve zoning changes to have Matt Wood codify changes in the form of an ordinance.

Mike Kendall – Threshold for filing liens on properties of 5K , said it was voted on previously and then it was amended to \$2,000.

Motion made to craft an ordinance self-imposing \$2000 minimum for filing liens. Motion made by Mike Kendall seconded by Andrew Clift, all voting in favor.

Police Report— Cody Stanley (Full report available upon request)

Fire Chief— Mike Steward (Full report available upon request)

Road and Light— Dave Radford, contacted the commissioner about rural municipal aid. He will be working on a bid book soon for the resurfacing project. Something about a bid book with the state being submitted.

Discussion held regarding eliminating parking on Pike Street due to visibility issues at the intersection with Pleasant.

Public Works— Jack moved the speed meter. Break in at 102 Kenton Jack re-secured the property.

Attorney Report— 102 Kenton has been served. Proceeding with foreclosure. SD1 lots, he has been doing legal analysis. Matt Woods brought up letting SD1 and Soccer organization do a direct lease with one another and keep the city out of negotiations as it has become complex.

Andrew Clift made a motion to let Matt Wood facilitate a deal between the soccer org and SD1 to work amongst themselves. Second by Mike Kendall– all voting in favor.

1st Reading of 2006-03-11 To increase council and mayor pay.

Dave Radford makes motion to accept second by Mike Kendall – all voting in favor

Ways and means – Mike Kendall, Budget needs to be amended at next month's meeting. Otherwise, nothing to report.

Insurance and Grants— Kelly Dudley, new assessment was performed, a few discrepancies need to be worked out.

Mayors Report – Person that bought the keyhole wants to set up medical marijuana, but city laws prohibit the operation of a dispensary.

Matt Woods reads aloud a letter from the owner of old Keyhole, Brian Wisher, expressing the idea of opening a dispensary.

Motion to block medical and recreational dispensaries (Marijuana) in the city of Bromley. Motion to have Matt Woods craft an ordinance. Motion made by Dave Radford, seconded by Mike Kendall. All voting in favor.

Mayor Denham—Reads two letters of intent for the empty council seat.

Dave Radford made a motion to bring Matt Walker onto the council, seconded by Mike Kendall all voting in favor.

Matt Woods -- swears in Matt Walker to fill the vacant council seat.

Committee Reports – Motion to accept report by Councilman Radford, seconded by Kelly Dudley, all voting in favor.

Old Business— Kelly Dudley, Discussion about street banners.

New Business— Kelly Dudley proposed placing engraved bricks at the site of the food pantry/library pocket park. These bricks will be available for purchase from the residents and info will be available on the city's social media.

Bills – Mike Kendall made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by Matt Walker, all voting in favor.

Motion to Adjourn— Dave Radford seconded by Matt Walker, all voting in favor.
