

Fiscal Year 2021 Public Bid Notice

The City of Bromley is accepting sealed bids for this Fiscal Year Snow Removal Program. This contract will run from 11/01/2021 through 4/30/2022.

1) The contractor will be responsible for removing snow and salting City streets as needed and requested. The contractor must provide vehicles, equipment, and salt/sand.

2) Bidder will need to provide two references along with proof of insurance for at least \$500,000.

Bidders will indemnify and hold the city harmless from any loss, claim or damage arising from any action or failure to act by the bidder or any of their agents, employees, or representatives in relation to the performance of activity connected to the bid.

This bid will automatically renew for the subsequent years under the same terms unless either party gives notice of cancellation 90 days prior to the end of each year.

Sealed bids must be postmarked no later than Wednesday, October 6th, 2021 @ 5:30 pm. The sealed bids will be opened at the regular council meeting to be held on Wednesday, October 6th, 2021, at 6:00 pm. The City of Bromley has the right to reject any and/or all bids, waive informalities, or accept any bid or combination thereof which appears to serve the best interest of the City of Bromley KY.

Below are the Basic Snow Removal guidelines.

The following street names and there linear footage for this snow removal contract are;

Short Street	350 LF.	Pleasant Street (250 LF. is an incline)	700 LF.
Kenton Street	900 LF.	Steve Tanner Street (250 LF. is an incline)	1200 LF.
Boone Street	1200 LF.	Rohman Street (250 LF. is an incline)	1200 LF.
Shelby Street	1600 LF.	Short Boone Street (250 LF. is an incline)	400 LF.
West Oak Street	350 LF.	Moore Street (600 LF. is an incline.)	1200 LF.
Hayward Street	600 LF.	Lake Street	200 LF.

These streets that are not included in the snow removal package:

Main Street (State maintained)
Bromley Crescent Springs Road (State maintained)
Highwater Road (county maintained)
Pike Street and River Road (state maintained)

If the forecasted weather is calling for less than 1 1/2" of snow and the high temperature for the day to be 32 degrees or above, you will only need to salt the street sections listed above as soon as scheduling allows and provide no removal for that snow event.

If the forecasted weather is calling for 2" or more of snow you will need to salt and plow all streets for that snow event based on the actual weather conditions as soon as scheduling allows.

Follow up snow removal will be required for each additional 2" of fresh snow, during any accumulating snow event beyond the original 2" rule.

In case of Ice Storms, you will need to treat all city streets as soon as scheduling allows.

You will need to have a backup policy in place to be able to provide this service encase of equipment failure.

During any event there could be the possibility of a specific request from the public works director (Bob France). Any questions concerning snow removal should be directed through Mr. France at 859-512-5663. In case of emergency and Bob France cannot be reached, you can contact the Mayor Mike Denham at 859-512-5663.

The city will provide a map to the accepted bidder, showing the plowing routes and any trouble areas in town, along with suggested plow bank storage locations.
